Full Planning:

Our Full Planning package is a true start-to-finish experience designed for couples who want expert guidance every step of the way. From venue recommendations and site visits to vendor selection, design development, and packing away décor at the end of the evening. We work closely together to create a seamless planning journey and bring your vision to life.

Investment:

- **\$4,500 flat fee** for venue weddings
- **Additional \$500** for backyard/private property weddings

Backyard weddings require additional logistics, rentals, and coordination, which is reflected in the adjusted fee.

Booking and payment structure

- \$1,000 deposit due via e-transfer upon signing the contract
- Final payment due 3 weeks before the wedding date
- All other payments will be evenly distributed between the deposit and final payment
- If I am required to travel outside of the GTA area a rate of \$0.65/km will be assessed to and from Liv & Love Weddings Studio. This amount will be calculated and added to the final invoice.

Full planning package includes:

- Comprehensive budget preparation, allocation, and ongoing management
- Curated vendor recommendations and assistance with vendor selection
- Review of all vendor contracts*, if desired
- Creation and maintenance of a detailed wedding planning timeline
- Full development and refinement of your chosen wedding aesthetic
- Design guidance including décor, florals, stationery, food presentation, attire, favors, and overall ambiance
- Attendance at vendor meetings, if desired
- Ongoing vendor communication and follow-ups
- Attendance at clergy meeting (ceremony discussion), if desired
- Supervision of wedding rehearsal
- Oversight of ceremony and reception setup
- On-site direction of ceremony
- Supervision of post-ceremony photo session
- Full on-site coordination of reception until end of evening
- One assistant included for the wedding day at no additional cost
